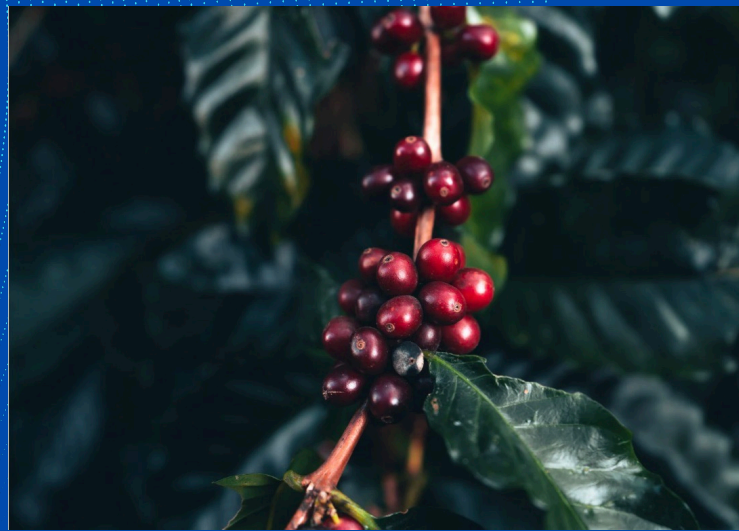

An integrated specialty coffee business combining cultivation, processing, and retail. The platform serves Sri Lanka's growing premium coffee segment through a traceable, single-origin model spanning from highland farm to cup.

The business is operational, brand-ready, and positioned to scale through both domestic and export growth.

- 85 hectares of leased land in Sri Lanka's Central Highlands
- 55,000 coffee plants under cultivation (Arabica)
- Current harvest: ~5.8 tons annually with potential for significant yield expansion

- Sales to premium hotels, restaurants, and repeat individual buyers
